#### **Becoming Disciples through Bible Study**

What is DISCIPLE Bible Study? DISCIPLE is an approach to Bible study that emphasizes disciplined reading of and listening to Scripture. Group members read over 80% of the Bible – beginning with Genesis journeying through Revelation. DISCIPLE groups have daily readings and meet once a week for 34 consecutive weeks (with breaks for holidays). Weekly meetings are 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> hours long. During weekly meetings we spend time in prayer, study and reflection.

DISCIPLE I groups consist of twelve members and a leader and meet weekly for 2 ½ hours for a period of 34 weeks (nine months). Each participant makes a commitment to daily preparation (30-60 minutes per day) and weekly participation in the group study sessions. Participants will have a study manual to use as a guide. The cost of the manual is \$36. If cost of the manual is an issue, please contact Laureen.

We will have one DISCIPLE I group this year. There will be an organizational meeting on Tuesday, August 26 at 7:00 p.m. On this evening participants will receive study guides, and have a brief orientation. If you would like to participate, please fill out the registration form (below) and return it to the church office by Aug. 10.

What happened next was a true testimony to the love of Christ in our midst. Tom was greeted with friendly smiles, words of compassion and invitations to join us for worship.




