


Church, we have our work cut out for us! From one day to the next jobless rates and gas prices are either up or down. Human relationships are faltering - fixated on each other's faults. While the media continues to highlight our troubles, we Disciples highlight hope. The scripture in Romans 5 reminds us that our hope is not in vain.



Our suffering and even our failures "produce endurance, and endurance character, and character hope hope that does not disappoint. . ." Our hope is in God, who gave us the Good News in Jesus Christ. It is this Good News that we proclaim in the witness and ministry of Reconciliation. Recently we received the following testimony from a ministry that benefited from your gifts to the Reconciliation Ministry special offering:

"Because of the grant that our local congregation-based organizing network BREAD (Building Responsibility, Equality and Dignity) received from Reconciliation Ministry, our congregation has been a part of a movement that actually changes systems - whether it is predatory lending, education, institutional racism, or unfair housing practices. Our church is one of 54 faith communities that work together to "do justice" in the city of Columbus. This year we are working collaboratively on Juvenile Justice. Last year we were able to reduce by half the number of youth in detention. I have learned that the work of "doing justice" is slow and it cannot be done alone. It requires perseverance and the willingness to work with others.

This work has been a blessing and transforming for me and my church. One of my members reported that because of this work, she now reads the paper differently. I recommend this kind of collaborative work to other churches." Your giving to Reconciliation Ministries is changing lives and communities. This special World Communion Sunday offering will be collected on September 28 and October 5. Thank you for your generosity.
