OUTREACH

Christmas in July continues for the remainder of this month as we collect toys for the children residing at Hope House. Your donation will be given to a child as a gift when he/she moves into the temporary residence at the Center of Hope for Women and Children. As we mentioned previously, many times these children enter the shelter without any possessions. A doll or toy to call their own can be extremely meaningful at this critical time in their young lives.

In August, we will again be collecting school supplies for area youth. This Outreach activity has proven to be very successful in helping children get off to a good start at the beginning of a new school year. Some suggestions include: large boxes of tissues, disinfectant wipes, antibacterial hand sanitizer, single subject notebooks, Crayola crayons (24 count), yellow #2 pencils, glue sticks and Expo dry erase markers. Search Committee Updates

Your search committee has met with Rev. Stephen Bentley from our Columbus office. We had a very good meeting with discussion on the time line of the search committee along with how the process will be administered. Pastor Nik met with as well, but will be one of the only meetings for him with the search committee. He is not to be a factor in determining our next settled minister, nor does he wish to influence that decision. He will be available to help answer any process questions along with Rev. Bentley, but should not be called upon to give opinions of the candidates that we are reviewing.

We have sent out а congregational survey for everyone to give us feedback. Please take these independently. Do not submit one for an entire household. We would like to have everyone's input for this process. If you need that link again you may email the office, Cliff Thompson or Larry Chamberlain and we will get it to you. There are also printed copies that vou can fill in and return to the office. A member of the search committee team will get your input added to the results.

Our next meeting will be 8/1 where we will be looking over our congregational profile and collaborating on how we present ourselves to a perspective candidate. There are a few other processes to go through, but in all, we hope to have candidates to begin reviewing before the end of September. This is a very involved and confidential time for the search committee. Please accept that fact that we will not be sharing information on the candidates until we have a settled pastor to enter into negotiations with. We are not trying to be secretive, but a matter of discretion is required to protect the candidates that are searching during their active time of ministry with another congregation.

We look forward to keeping you updated on our progress and ask that as we go through this journey together that you pray for the search team that we will be open to hearing who God is calling as our next settled pastor for First Christian in Middletown. We are working diligently, but not rushing through this process.
