- 5. All meetings of your Search Committee are closed and only open to members of the committee.

This process of Search and Call can take up to four to six months or longer. Be patient! God works on His time and not ours. In the meantime, I will stand faithfully with you until that day when your settled pastor is ready to begin.

I will not be able to be back with you and in the saddle, so to say, until the doctor has given me permission to drive.

I again want to reaffirm what a pleasure it is to serve as your interim pastor.
