A decision has been made and will be recommended to the General Board at the next meeting. Property is recommending a fixed FCC logo portion on the top similar to the previous one and a digital lower portion. This will allow us to change presentations easily from the church office and will allow for multiple items rotating on the sign instead of just one, as was the case with our old sign. As delivery will be 10-12 weeks after submitting the order, a multi-purpose banner has been ordered and will soon be fastened within the opening on the sign frame. This will help to keep our name in front of the public and dispel any rumors of us ceasing to exist. At this time, cost of this new sign will be a little more than \$17,500.00. Insurance will cover \$8,551.00 of that amount. There is still time for you to contribute toward this purchase. Just put your contribution in offering plate and note that it is "for the sign".
