(Psalm 139:1)


You know my thoughts before they form,

"FEED MY SHEEP GARDEN" MINISTRIES FINAL REPORT

Our garden has been extremely productive this year. Most of our produce was given to the Salvation Army Food Store and a small amount was given to the Monroe Nazarene Church Food Pantry (they had no fresh produce). Here is a listing of the yields for this year:

- 137 Radishes
- 170 Yellow Squash
- 194 Zucchini Squash
- 68 Acorn Squash
- 172 Green Peppers
- 53.5# Green Beans
- 276 Ears of Sweet Corn
- 651 Cucumbers

That all adds up to <u>1171 pounds of produce</u> for 2020. We have, truly, been blessed this year! All plants have been pulled. We will soon till the plot and add nourishment for next spring. Also, as we begin the planning for what we will be planting in 2021, we have learned a few "do's & don'ts" during this past summer

GREEN CHALICE STATUS!

After work on the part of our trustees, property team, New Beginnings team, and the entire congregation we have been granted standing as a Green Chalice Congregation.

The purpose of the Green Chalice Program is to encourage and assist local congregations/DOC Offices and Assemblies who wish to live out their faith by caring for creation. This program is designed to recognize congregations for being good stewards of God's creation. It also aims to empower congregations/assemblies with ideas and resources to enable them to walk gently on the earth.
