NOTES FROM FINANCE- 2020

This year taxpayers are entitled to a charitable contribution deduction even if they don't itemize their deductions. Usually there is no tax benefit for giving to charity unless you itemize your deductions on Schedule A of your tax return. The CARES Act (passed by Congress earlier this year) created an above-the-line deduction of up to \$300 for charitable contributions from taxpayers who don't itemize.
