NOTES FROM FINANCE

As we are preparing to mail the fourth quarter giving statements, we would like to repeat an article from our October issue of the Chalice Communicator. Please include your statement in your tax records from 2020.

"This year taxpayers are entitled to a charitable contribution deduction even if you don't itemize your deductions. Usually there is no tax benefit for giving to charity unless you itemize your deductions on Schedule A of your tax return. The CARES Act (passed by Congress earlier this year) created an above-the-line deduction of up to \$300 for charitable contributions from taxpayers who don't itemize.
