Middletown Interfaith Clothes Closet


We've Got you Covered

CENTRAL ACADEMY VISIT

We had a great visit with the kindergarten kids at Central Academy this morning. Dave and I went there with cucumber seeds, pots, and labels. We showed them two videos – one dealing with seed germination in general and the other specifically with cucumbers. There were many questions and they seemed very excited to be able to start their own seeds. We, also, had pots for each of the teachers. We told them they could see how well they did and just how "good" the teachers were with growing seeds – a wee bit of competition. The teachers seemed to like this idea, as well. We have developed a good working relationship with this particular school and I feel this effort compliments our relationship. Dave and I agreed to return once their seeds have sprouted and they have actual plants to share. When we left, we gave them a sheet with pictures of just how a cucumber seed sprouts and how the sprouted seeds grow into an actual plant. All in all, this was a very positive visit.
