Let's Talk Care Portal

There has been a lot of talk about the CarePortal lately in our church, so I thought I would take a second and review what we are doing with this program! CarePortal is linking caseworkers in schools and children services to churches and churches to families in desperate need. Faith in this system continues to grow stronger one child at a time. Our church may be small in size but enormous in its love for children, especially those in need. Becoming part of CarePortal, we became the caring part.

Let's look at how it works. A single older mom is raising her children and helping raise her grandchildren, she gets laid off and she can't pay her \$700 rent bill, our church could help with some or all of this need through CarePortal. We can get into the platform to get THAT need right here in our city. The family and the need are already vetted by caseworkers and verified that it is a need that could keep this family from being homeless and stop her from losing these children to the system before it even starts! The needs may range from the aforementioned to a bed or even a car seat.

Mike Fox, the founder of Global Orphan Project, developed this technology. He has seen parents lose custody because they couldn't afford the necessities. He says until this, "you as the case worker can really do only about one thing, and that's pick up the child and put them in the system. This allows a lot of corrections to happen before the child gets into the system." After the agency worker meets with the family, they will come to CarePortal, through CarePortal, a family's needs are entered into the site. This is when we as the church go to work. We have the choice to help completely, partially, with the items needed or monetary means. But most of all we are asked to pray

over the situation. There is an actual button to select that allows the workers to know we are praying! Then we go talk to the families offer them community, love and Jesus and meet their needs. They may not come to church right away, but they know God has intervened in a potentially devastating situation and the seed is planted!

That is our calling in the great commission. Our church has helped sixteen kids and has contributed \$3,200 dollars in total help so far this year. Sixteen kids that could have wound up in foster care! On top of that we have helped 4 other churches deliver items and minister to 10 families. The world is seeing the church work as one body! If you feel led to start working in this ministry in any way contact Pastor Jeff or Kobi and we will get you set up.
