INK RECYCLING PROGRAM

Every six months we renew our rewards membership at Staples. As long as we turn in used ink cartridges, we are given store credit which helps immensely in offsetting our office expenses. In order to participate in the Staples reward program, we must purchase \$50 in ink supplies. (This was recently raised from \$30.) FMS GARDEN REPORT

Our Garden has been planted and is beginning to yield produce. As of mid-July, we have been able to donate 175.5 lbs. of fresh produce (yellow squash, zucchini, cucumbers, and green peppers) to our local Salvation Army Food Pantry. We are looking to be starting to pick from our first sweet corn planting. However, this is not turning out to be a very good garden year. We have planted green beans three different times and each time, the sprouts have been nibbled to the ground. We think this is due to the very large population of rabbits on our property. We have some ideas and may make changes for next year. However, it has gotten too late in the year to try planting beans another time. We were late getting a second planting of sweet corn in due to weather delays. We did manage to get one in, but it appears that some of the seed was washed out during a heavy rain. Yields on this second planting are expected to be poor. We have been blessed for two years with good crop yields but this third year is turning out to be a significant challenge.

Even though we are not anticipating a very good year, we will still need to weed and you should expect a call for help in that arena.

In response to some very helpful feedback the Regional Assembly Planning Committee has redesigned our Saturday, September 24 Regional Assembly, "A Family Reunion" at Camp Christian. *It is now going to be shorter and free!** Through the generosity of a donor, all of the food costs will be covered. We are hoping to still receive other donations to cover the program, utility, administrative, and staffing costs for Camp Christian, but the Regional Assembly Planning Committee is thrilled to offer this day of celebration at no cost to those who pre-register. *For persons who register the day of the event, or show up on site without pre-registration, a \$5.00 registration fee will be required. We are also asking exhibitors and vendors with booths to register for the original \$40 to help underwrite the costs. A new Registration Form is now available on the Regional Website, www.CCinOH.org and also attached to this email.

The Regional Assembly will now begin with registration at 10 a.m. on Saturday, September 24 and the program beginning at 11 a.m. We will still have a very short Regional Business Meeting (including the election of our new Regional Church Council), a picnic-style lunch, followed by an afternoon full of games (table, competitive, and group), live music, booths hosted by our Regional and General Ministry Partners, crafts for the entire family, tours of Camp Christian, fishing, boating, and "Green Chair Chats," as well as other fun possibilities. The day will conclude with worship starting at 3 p.m. that will include Communion. We hope the new 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. time frame will be better for everyone, especially those driving from farther away.

More than anything, we are excited to offer a chance for wonderful fellowship with friends and colleagues from around the Christian Church in Ohio and beyond. Adults, youth, and children are encouraged to attend. The Assembly is designed for all ages, and there will also be child care for Children ages 4 to 12 during the opening gathering and business meeting.
